

SCHOLARSHIP INFO

- We will be awarding a minimum of two scholarships at each of the 11 regular Cattlelac shows and three at each of the 4 Super Point Shows. These 34 - \$1,000 scholarships will be chosen by a random draw. Each animal entered in both ring A&B will give the kid a chance for the scholarship.
- Every entry for each show you attend will enter you into the drawing for a minimum of 10 additional Year End Scholarships.
- The number of Scholarships will be dependent on the amount of scholarship funds we raise. We will be awarding 2 additional scholarships, one to a steer exhibitor and one to a heifer exhibitor. These scholarships will be chosen from individuals who are in the Top 5 of the following categories: Supreme Exhibitor, Division, and Showmanship.

WE ARE GUARANTEEING TO GIVE AWAY \$50,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS FOR 2026

- For each show that we have 200 head or more we will give away an additional \$1,000 Scholarship in the form of a drawing for just the kids that entered at that show. If we get 300 head, we will give another \$1,000 scholarship and will do this with each additional 100 head i.e. 400, 500, 600.
So, if we have 200 head or more at every show, we will give an additional 15 - \$1,000 Scholarships for the 2026 Cattlelac show season.
- Exhibitors are eligible to win multiple scholarships per year but are eligible to only win one scholarship per show.

Only exhibitors ages 21 or younger as of January 1st will be eligible for the scholarship(s).

- After winning a scholarship, we will present you with a scholarship certificate at the next show you attend, so be sure when you check in to let us know so we can present you with your certificate.
- In order to redeem your scholarship, you must enroll in an institution of higher learning such as a College, Junior College, or a trade school. Then send Scott Jones proof of enrollment and we will send a check to that institution.
- Any individual receiving a Cattlelac scholarship must redeem the scholarship within three years after their high school graduation date.
- If for any reason the Cattlelac Elite Livestock Events, LLC. ceases to operate we will distribute all scholarship funds to those exhibitors the funds are due to. Some funds may be tied up in Certificate of

Deposit, if so, they will be paid out as soon as the CD expires.
